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PEER TO PEER RECOVERY SUPPORT

The main goal of the peer-to-peer model is to engage and encourage peers in recovery from substance use to learn to live a more productive life, and share their knowledge and experience with other members of the center, creating an environment where one peer helps another. Staff are on site all times during open hours, but play a minimal role. The heartbeat of the center is one peer helping another. Staff is available to also provide any additional resources that may help peers in this process.

ELIGIBILITY

People who identify as being in recovery and who wish to work on their recovery are eligible for Recovery Coaching. These support services are free of charge.

ADVISORY BOARD

In addition to peers engaging one another and creating an environment of change, a Members Board has been established. The board holds the responsibilities of listening to the ideas of the community of members at the center, organizing and developing these ideas, and collaborating with staff and the community at large to make the center a success.
